The group which has been chosen to discern the future direction of Hope Community with regard to the heating situation as well as the financial and membership concerns has been formed and met for the first time following the worship service on January 19.

They chose to operate under the name of the HCPC Task Force. Members of the group are Pete Wilhelm, Sue Stevens, Irene Salo, Craig Mason, Sylvia Chad and Steve or Ann Badanjak, who will trade off attendance at meetings. The Task Force will plan to meet twice a month, with Pastor Kate Stangl facilitating one meeting per month.

At the first meeting, organizational items were dealt with and responsibilities were discussed. Prior to the next meeting on February 2 the results of the survey from the town hall meeting of December 15 will be analyzed in order to give us an idea of the congregation's thinking in order to give us a good starting point for our discussions.

Our defining tasks are to plan what to do about the necessary heat conversion and to get a sense of how long we can realistically remain a viable church and what our options are in that regard.

The main issue to come out of this meeting is that we recommend pricing the CE Building to sell as quickly as possible in order to free us from the responsibilities of its ownership.

soup pots out on Sunday the 9th.


One Great Hour of Sharing
