Church Forum

You may remember that Sue Stevens wrote and received a Church Vitality grant from the presbytery to help fund special worship events and forums. The first forum will be a collaboration between our church and Faithful Earth Keepers. The forum will take place on Saturday, February 7 at 1pm in the church basement. The topic will be “Support Wildlife, Biodiversity, and Beauty Where You Live!” We'll watch a video presentation by entomologist, Dr. Doug Tallamy, on how even small efforts can have big impacts for wildlife and pollinator populations. Then we'll hear from Dan Schutte from Shoreview Natives in Two Harbors on the how-to's of creating small or large native plant habitat on your property. Per Capita


